INSTRUCTIONS

Here are some instructions for our new line of green dyes for mosses:

- it cannot be used on its own: it needs to be diluted in water. However, we recommend diluting it into a mix of water and glycerin (which we can also supply).
- use a spray bottle to apply it to the moss; make sure to spread it evenly.
- start with a low dilution and add your water and glycerin mix until you achieve the desired colour.

!! the more you dilute, the lighter the color of the dye will become !!

- we highly recommend testing your dilution on a piece of moss before applying it to the wall.
- the same dilution will not always provide the same color on various moss species as they will absorb it differently.
- the total area of coverage will be directly related to how much spray is added to the wall (500 ml of water \pm 500 ml of glycerin should be enough for 50 sqft of wall space).
